Permits & authorizations (utility, city and home owners association)		
Home insurance due diligence		
Any applicable code compliance (existing and new)		
Post-installation inspections and needed repairs		
Ongoing inspections and repairs		
Structural damage to home during installation		
Replacing defective hardware and/or software		
Warranty enforcement if manufacturer goes out of business		
Ownership of data generated by equipment		
Ownership of renewable energy credits		
Removal and repair of roof at the end of term (if leased)		
Transfer of leasing contract or loan to new owners when selling your home
